

# Cluck Cluck | Heart You Mini


Finished size: 10" x 19 3/4"

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## **Material Requirements:**

- Heart 1: Print 12" square or cut pieces from non-directional yardage
  - Heart 2: Print 10" square or cut pieces from non-directional yardage
  - Heart 3: Print 8" square or cut pieces from non-directional yardage
  - Heart 4: Print 5" square or large non directional scrap
- ½ yard white fabric
- 1 fat quarter backing fabric
- 1 fat quarter binding fabric
- cotton batting






All seam allowances are 1/4". "Right sides together" has been abbreviated to "RST".

- 1. From the white fabric cut and set aside the following for the borders and final layout:
  - 2 strips 1 ½" x WOF. Set aside the strips for the borders.
  - 1 strip 2 ½" x WOF. Sub-cut (1) 2 ½" x 5 ¼" strip, and (1) 2 ½" x 10 ¼" strip.
  - From the scrap of the 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, cut (1) 2" x 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip.


## 2. Make Heart 1:


- A. From the Heart 1 fabric cut:
  - (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" strip, (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strip, (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strip, (1) 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" square (save this for Heart 2)
- B. From the white fabric cut:
  - (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" square, (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" square, (4) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares
- C. Layout the print pieces as shown and the white  $4 \frac{1}{2}$  square and  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  squares (a).
- D. Place the white squares on the bottom of the print  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips as shown, RST. Draw a pencil line from corner to corner on the white squares (b). Sew along the pencil lines, trim the corners leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press the seams open (c).
- E. Place the white  $1\frac{1}{2}$  squares in the top corners of the print  $4\frac{1}{2}$  and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  strips as shown, RST. Draw pencil lines from corner to corner (d), sew along the pencil lines, trim the corners (e), and press the seams open (f). Set the pieces aside.



















#### 3. Make Heart 2:

- A. From the Heart 2 fabric cut:
  - (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strip, (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strip, (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strip, (1) 1" x 1" square (save this for Heart 3)
- B. From the white fabric cut:
  - (1) 3 ½" x 3 ½" square, (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" square, (3) 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" squares
- C. Layout the print pieces as shown and the white 3 ½" square and 2 ½" squares (q).
- D. Place the squares on the bottom of the strips as you did with Heart 1, draw a diagonal pencil line from corner to corner, sew along the pencil line, trim corners (h), and press seams open.
- E. Layout the white 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" squares, and the 1 ¼" square from Heart 1 in the upper left corner of the 3 ½" strip. Draw diagonal lines (i), sew along the pencil lines, trim the corners (j), and press the seams open (k). Set the Heart 2 pieces aside.




#### 4. Make Heart 3:

- A. From the Heart 3 fabric cut:
  - (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strip, (1) 2" x 2 ½" strip, (1) 1 ¾" x 3" strip, (1) ½" x ½" square (save this for Heart 4)
- B. From the white fabric cut:
  - (1) 2 ½" x 2 ½" square, (1) 1 ¾" x 1 ¾" square, (3) 1" x 1" squares
- C. Layout the print pieces as shown and the white 2 ½" square and 1 ¾" squares (I).
- D. Place the squares on the bottom of the strips as you did with Heart 2, draw a diagonal pencil line from corner to corner, sew along the pencil line, trim corners (m), and press seams open.
- E. Layout the white  $1" \times 1"$  squares, and the 1" square from Heart 2 in the upper left corner of the  $2 \frac{1}{2}"$  strip. Draw diagonal lines (n), sew along the pencil lines, trim the corners (o), and press the seams open (p). Set the Heart 3 pieces aside.





#### 5. Make Heart 4:


A. From the Heart 4 fabric cut:



1 ¾" square (q)









- B. From the white fabric cut:
  - (2) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares, (3) 7/8" x 7/8" squares
- C. Layout the print pieces as shown and the white 1 3/4" squares (g).
- D. Place the squares on the bottom of the strips as you did with Heart 2, draw a diagonal pencil line from corner to corner, sew along the pencil line, trim corners (r), and press seams open.
- E. Layout the white  $\frac{1}{3}$  x  $\frac{1}{3}$  squares, and the  $\frac{1}{3}$  square from Heart 3 in the upper left corner. Draw diagonal lines, sew along the pencil lines, trim the corners (s), and press the seams open (t). The heart block should measure 3" square.

### 6. Assemble the center:


A. Layout Heart 4, the pieces from Heart 3, and the white 2" x 2 ¼" strip as shown. Sew the pieces RST as shown, press seams open as you go.



B. Layout the pieces from Heart 2, and the white 2 ½" x 5 ¼" strip as shown. Sew the pieces RST, press seams open.



C. Layout the pieces from Heart 1, and the white 2 ½" x 10 ¼" strip as shown. Sew the pieces RST, press open.



- 7. Measure the sides and cut a 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " white border strip to that length (8  $\frac{1}{2}$ "). Sew the strips to each side RST. Press open. Repeat to add the top and bottom border (the strips should be approx. 20  $\frac{1}{4}$ ").
- 8. Trim the backing to size leaving 2" around the quilt top. Layer the quilt top right side up, batting, and backing right side down. Baste and quilt as desired. Cut 4 strips 2" x 20" from the fat quarter and bind using your favorite method.
