

# Lovestruck



## A Quilt Block Pattern

Finished Block Size: 17" x 17"  
Without borders: 10" x 17"



### Materials and Cutting Instructions:

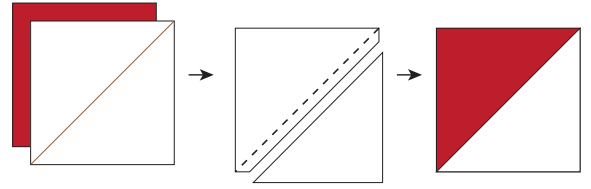
Fabrics for the Block:	Cut the following pieces from each fabric:
Red Heart Fabric	1 strip 5 1/2" x 4 1/2" 1 square 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" 1 strip 5 1/2" x 10 1/2"
Brown Arrow Fabric	1 strip 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" 2 strips 1 1/2" x 3" 1 strip 1 1/2" x 4" 1 strip 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" 1 strip 2" x 3 1/2"
White Background Fabric	6 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" 2 strips 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" 2 squares 2" x 2" 4 squares 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" 2 strips 4" x 3 1/2" 2 strips 4" x 4 1/2" 2 squares 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" 2 strips 4" x 17 1/2" (for top and bottom border)

### Before you Begin:

1. Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout. All block pieces are sewn right sides together.
2. I recommend pressing seams open throughout, with all of the seams in this block it will reduce bulk.
3. If you have Diagonal Seam Tape, it will save you a lot of time when making this block! You can use anywhere in the pattern where it says to "draw a diagonal line", and use the Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide instead. Link is below.

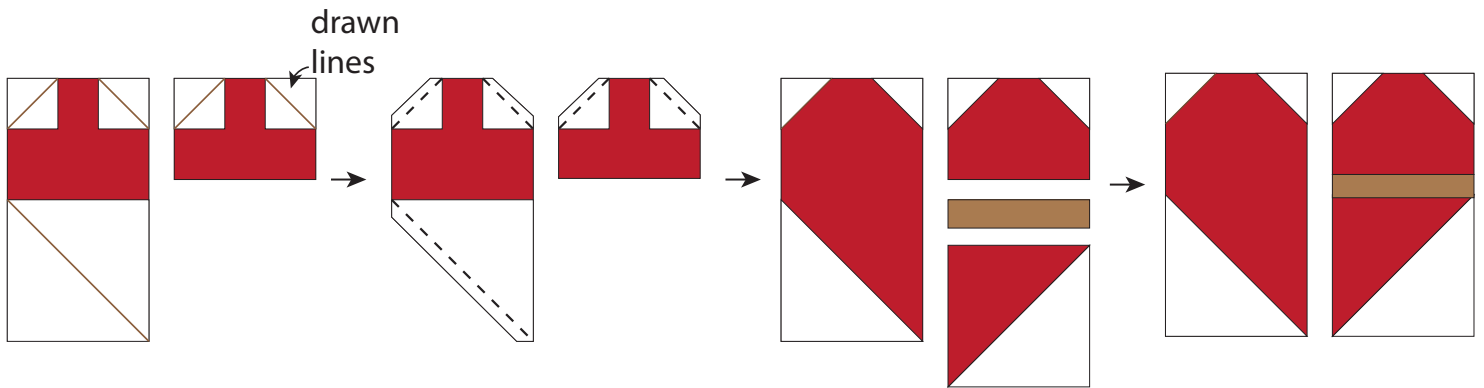
## Block Assembly:

- Place the red  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square and the white  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a square. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim one corner off of the squares, leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", press. The half square triangle should measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square, trim the edges as needed.



- Layout the red strip pieces as shown below. Place a  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " background square in each top corner of the red strips, right sides together. Place a  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " white square on the bottom of the  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " red strip. Draw diagonal lines from corner to corner as shown below on the wrong sides of the background squares. Sew on the drawn lines, trim the corners leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press the seams.

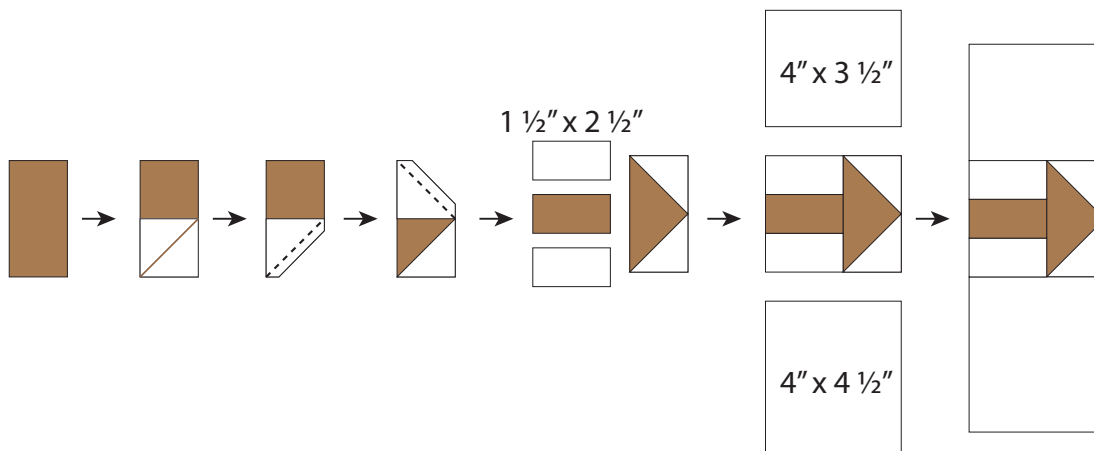
- Layout the pieces from above with the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " brown strip, and the half square triangle from step 1 as shown. Sew the strips and square together to form the right heart side, press seams.



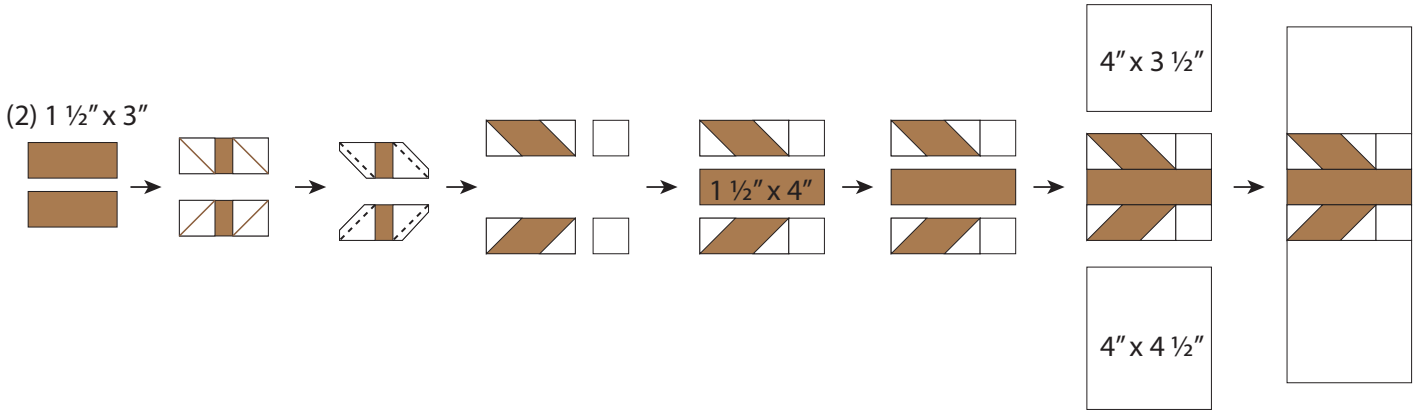
- Place a 2" white square on the bottom of the brown  $2$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Sew on the line, trim the corner leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press. Repeat with the other 2" square in the top corner of the strip.

- Layout the brown  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, with a white  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip on the top and bottom. Sew the strips together and press. Sew the arrow point strip, to the strips as shown below. Press.

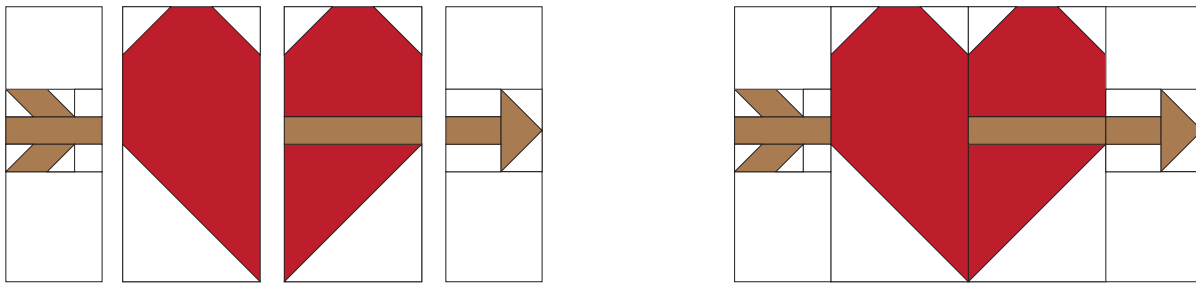
- Sew a white  $4$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top of the arrow unit, and a  $4$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The arrow strip unit should measure  $4$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- On the 2 brown  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3''$  strips, place a  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving  $\frac{1}{4}''$ , and press. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
- Place the brown  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4''$  strip in between the strips from above, and sew the strips together, press. Sew a white  $4'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$  strip to the top of the tail unit, and a  $4'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The tail strip unit should measure  $4'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ .



- On the 2 brown  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3''$  strips, place a  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving  $\frac{1}{4}''$ , and press. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
- Place the brown  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4''$  strip in between the strips from above, and sew the strips together, press. Sew a white  $4'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$  strip to the top of the tail unit, and a  $4'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The tail strip unit should measure  $4'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ .



- Layout the block pieces as shown, and sew the strips together, press. The block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$ .
- Sew a  $4'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$  white strip to the top and bottom of the block, press. The block should measure  $17\frac{1}{2}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}''$ .
