

## Materials and Cutting Instructions:

| Fabrics for the Block: | Cut the following pieces from each fabric: |
| :---: | :---: |
| Red Heart Fabric | $\begin{aligned} & 1 \text { strip } 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ & 1 \text { square } 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ & 1 \text { strip } 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \end{aligned}$ |
| Brown Arrow Fabric | $\begin{aligned} & 1 \text { strip } 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ & 2 \text { strips } 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime} \\ & 1 \text { strip } 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime} \\ & 1 \text { strip } 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 511 / 2^{\prime \prime} \\ & 1 \text { strip } 2^{\prime \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime} \end{aligned}$ |

## Before you Begin:

1. Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance throughout. All block pieces are sewn right sides together.
2. I recommend pressing seams open throughout, with all of the seams in this block it will reduce bulk.
3. If you have Diagonal Seam Tape, it will save you a lot of time when making this block! You can use anywhere in the pattern where it says to "draw a diagonal line", and use the Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide instead. Link is below. https://cluckclucksewshop.com/products/diagonal-seam-tape

## Block Assembly:

1. Place the red $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and the white $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a square. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim one corner off of the squares, leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, press. The half square triangle should measure $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, trim the edges as needed.

2. Layout the red strip pieces as shown below. Place a $2 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ background square in each top corner of the red strips, right sides together. Place a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white square on the bottom of the $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red strip. Draw diagonal lines from corner to corner as shown below on the wrong sides of the background squares. Sew on the drawn lines, trim the corners leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press the seams.
3. Layout the pieces from above with the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ brown strip, and the half square triangle from step 1 as shown. Sew the strips and square together to form the right heart side, press seams.

4. Place a $2^{\prime \prime}$ white square on the bottom of the brown $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Sew on the line, trim the corner leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press. Repeat with the other $2^{\prime \prime}$ square in the top corner of the strip.
5. Layout the brown $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1 / 2 " \prime}{\prime \prime}$ strip, with a white $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strip on the top and bottom. Sew the strips together and press. Sew the arrow point strip, to the strips as shown below. Press.
6. Sew a white $4 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strip to the top of the arrow unit, and a $4 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The arrow strip unit should measure $4^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

7. On the 2 brown $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ strips, place a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press. Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
 $4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of the tail unit, and a 4 " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press.
The tail strip unit should measure 4 " $\times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

8. On the 2 brown $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ strips, place a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, and press. Sew a $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
9. Place the brown $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip in between the strips from above, and sew the strips together, press. Sew a white $4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of the tail unit, and a $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The tail strip unit should measure $4^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 \prime 2}$.

10. Layout the block pieces as shown, and sew the strips together, press. The block should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
11. Sew a 4 " $\times 17^{11 / 2 "}$ white strip to the top and bottom of the block, press. The block should measure $17 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 17{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.


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
