Lovestruck Cluck Cluck A Quilt Block Pattern



Finished Block Size: 17" x 17" Without borders: 10" x 17"



Materials and Cutting Instructions:


Fabrics for the Block:	Cut the following pieces from each fabric:
Red Heart Fabric	1 strip 5 ½" x 4 ½" 1 square 5 ½" x 5 ½" 1 strip 5 ½" x 10 ½"
Brown Arrow Fabric	1 strip 1 ½" x 2 ½" 2 strips 1 ½" x 3" 1 strip 1 ½" x 4" 1 strip 1 ½" x 5 ½" 1 strip 2" x 3 ½"
White Background Fabric	6 squares 1 ½" x 1 ½" 2 strips 1 ½" x 2 ½" 2 squares 2" x 2" 4 squares 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" 2 strips 4" x 3 ½" 2 strips 4" x 4 ½" 2 squares 5 ½" x 5 ½" 2 strips 4" x 17 ½" (for top and bottom border)

Before you Begin:


- 1. Use a ¹/₄" seam allowance throughout. All block pieces are sewn right sides together.
- 2. I recommend pressing seams open throughout, with all of the seams in this block it will reduce bulk.
- 3. If you have Diagonal Seam Tape, it will save you a lot of time when making this block! You can use anywhere in the pattern where it says to "draw a diagonal line", and use the Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide instead. Link is below. https://cluckclucksewshop.com/products/diagonal-seam-tape

Block Assembly:


 Place the red 5 ¹/₂" square and the white 5 ¹/₂" squares right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a square. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim one corner off of the squares, leaving ¹/₄", press. The half square triangle should measure 5 ¹/₂" square, trim the edges as needed.




- 2. Layout the red strip pieces as shown below. Place a 2 ¼" background square in each top corner of the red strips, right sides together. Place a 5 ½" white square on the bottom of the 10 ½" red strip. Draw diagonal lines from corner to corner as shown below on the wrong sides of the background squares. Sew on the drawn lines, trim the corners leaving ¼", and press the seams.
- 3. Layout the pieces from above with the 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" brown strip, and the half square triangle from step 1 as shown. Sew the strips and square together to form the right heart side, press seams.




- 4. Place a 2" white square on the bottom of the brown 2" x 3 ½" strip, and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Sew on the line, trim the corner leaving 1/4", and press. Repeat with the other 2" square in the top corner of the strip.
- 5. Layout the brown 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strip, with a white 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strip on the top and bottom. Sew the strips together and press. Sew the arrow point strip, to the strips as shown below. Press.
- 6. Sew a white 4" x 3 ½" strip to the top of the arrow unit, and a 4" x 4 ½" white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The arrow strip unit should measure 4" x 10 ½".




- 7. On the 2 brown 1 1/2" x 3" strips, place a 1 1/2" white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving 1/4", and press. Sew a 1 1/2" white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
- 8. Place the brown 1 1/2" x 4" strip in between the strips from above, and sew the strips together, press. Sew a white 4" x 3 1/2" strip to the top of the tail unit, and a 4" x 4 1/2" white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The tail strip unit should measure 4" x 10 1/2".




- 9. On the 2 brown 1 1/2" x 3" strips, place a 1 1/2" white square in the corners as shown below. Draw lines on the white squares as shown below, sew on the lines, trim the corners leaving 1/4", and press. Sew a 1 1/2" white square to the right side of each strip as shown below.
- Place the brown 1 ¹/₂" x 4" strip in between the strips from above, and sew the strips together, press. Sew a white 4" x 3 ¹/₂" strip to the top of the tail unit, and a 4" x 4 ¹/₂" white strip to the bottom of the unit. Press. The tail strip unit should measure 4" x 10 ¹/₂".





- 11. Layout the block pieces as shown, and sew the strips together, press. The block should measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 12. Sew a 4" x 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " white strip to the top and bottom of the block, press. The block should measure 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



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
